- 1. Locate support clips on back of panel quantity 4 or 6 depending on light fixture Fig. 1.
- 2. Mark corresponding mounting locations on ceiling surfaces 4 or 6 depending on model.
- 3. Affix each cable assembly to ceiling with appropriate fasteners (not supplied).
- Position panel and attach spring clips on cable assemblies to holes on corresponding support clips. Use one cable assembly for each support clip.
- 5. Depress plunger pin on adjustable cable locks to adjust cables for even support and height for wiring.
- 6. Make wiring connections per fixture instructions and applicable codes.
- Depress plunger pins and adjust height and level of each cable assembly as required for desired height, level and even support.
- 8. Add any additional support if required by code.
- 9. Verify security of installation.
- 10. Installation complete.
